Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Applications for students to join the St John's Instrumental Music Program in 2026 are now open. In 2026, students from Year 3 – 12 may learn a string instrument, and students from Year 4 - 12 may learn a string, brass, woodwind, or percussion instrument.

What is the Instrumental Music Program?

The Instrumental Music Program is a co-curricular subject in which students learn to play a brass, woodwind, percussion, or string instrument. The purpose of the Instrumental Music Program is to provide students with the opportunity to become musicians and experience the expressive qualities of music through learning to play a band or orchestral instrument.

The core focus of the Instrumental Music Program is learning to play in a group or ensemble. All instrumental music students are required to have a weekly group lesson and participate in an ensemble.

Each semester, students are also required to complete assessment through performance of music and technical exercises, in both groups and as individuals. Student progress is reported to parents via the Semester 1 and 2 reports.

There are countless benefits for children who learn to play a musical instrument and as students progress in their playing, opportunities for performances, camps and workshops arise at district, regional and state levels.

If your child is interested in learning a musical instrument in 2026, please complete the attached Physical Test Permission Form and Expression of Interest forms and return to the office by Friday 17th October.

Students will undergo instrument sizing and testing during Term 4, and successful applicants will be notified by the end of the school year.
